HARASSMENT POLICY
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In general, Charlotte Writers Group has a general no-harassment policy, which means any and all form of harassment is prohibited by CWG and the organization staff. This includes, without exception:

- Verbal harassment
- Digital harassment (emails, texts, photos)
- Physical harassment
- Sexual harassment
- Professional harassment (plagiarism, slander, libel, etc...)

If any report of harassment is reported to the organizational staff of CWG will be met with an in-depth investigation of all parties involved, and depending on severity and ability to reach an acceptable solution through mediation, may include communication with local and national law enforcement. We will acquiesce with all legal and law enforcement entities on behalf of injured parties, at the request of that party and their legal representation. Any evidence involving a dispute will be saved and released upon reasonable and legal request of injured parties.

CWG reserves the right to ban and bar any member from future participation in any CWG functions and events, without a reason given, if a member is found to be a repeated offender or fails to meet any resolutions created in mediation.

Decisions in this regard are final.
